Qualifications

1. Committed Christian woman, single or married

4. Good spiritual, physical, and emotional health. Must have annual physicals including TB skin test (cost covered by House of Mary)
5. Education, training, and experience sufficient for the position of House Mother
 - a. Training will be provided for HoM Policy & Procedures so that she is able to maintain the home while house parents are out.
6. Have no substantiated report as perpetrator of neglect or abuse.
 - a. Background checks will be performed for all house parents and relief house parents

Responsibilities

To give house parents relief for 48 hours weekly. To minister and live with pregnant women during that time; to model the love of Christ through their actions and lifestyle to women facing one of the greatest crises of their lives.

Work Schedule

Relief House Mother serves in a part-time shift work capacity. She is needed to allow the regular House Parents time off.. This relief time is scheduled on a monthly basis and includes 48 hour rotations each week. If the Relief House Mother is unable to fulfill the scheduled work times, she must notify the house parent as soon as possible.
